CARSON SCHOLARS: HEROES AMONG US

After two years of virtual ceremonies, the Carson Scholarship Program was thrilled to provide the opportunity for scholars, families, educators and funders to come together to honor the heroes among us, our 2022 new and recognized scholars.

During the month of May, scholars from across the country were invited to one of seven movie premieres to watch a short original film titled "Carson Scholars: Heroes Among Us." In addition to their cameo in the movie, Dr. and Mrs. Carson worked tirelessly to attend the majority of the premieres and recognize the amazing accomplishment of each scholar- hero. They greeted them, provided words of wisdom and encouragement, posed for photographs and ate a lot of popcorn!



The film tells the story of two extraterrestrials who were sent to Earth to find the best and the brightest. After seeing a commercial about the 2022 Carson Scholars they head out to find these brilliant young stars. Movie theatre snacks and drinks were provided, medals and pins were handed out and scholars donned capes as they walked across the stage to be recognized for the momentous accomplishment of being named a Carson Scholar.

Across the nation, 547 new students were named 2022 Carson Scholars. They will receive a \$1,000 college scholarship, a personalized medal and certificate of accomplishment.

In addition to this outstanding group, 803 students earned the prestigious status of being named a 2022 Recognized Scholar. These students continue to exhibit the qualities of a Carson Scholar by reaching high academic standards and continuing their community service initiatives. They were honored with a commemorative pin, certificate of accomplishment and an invitation to the movie premiere.

Not only are 2022 Carson Scholars over the top brilliant, but they are also kind and compassionate leaders in their communities. These students are researching cures for diseases, starting non-profits, donating items to those in need, hosting food drives, caring for the elderly, teaching young ones — and the list goes on!

The Ben Carson Reading Project Marks a Milestone with the Opening of the 250th Ben Carson Reading Room!

The Carson Scholars Fund's 250th Ben Carson Reading Room, located at Henderson Elementary School in Midland, Texas, is inspired by the 2021 Disney Pixar movie "Luca." The backdrop of this reading room is the picturesque Italian Riviera. Several scenes from the movie are brought to life in the expansive (28' x 43') reading room. Students can set their imaginations assail in a threeperson canoe. For those who prefer to stay ashore, they can spend time in the bistro with a sweeping view of the entire reading room. Others may choose to stretch out on top of a loft beneath the glow of twinkling lights or nestle under the loft on comfy pillows shaped like tree stumps. One of the central features





of the reading room is a book fountain. Students thirsting for knowledge can take a sip or immerse themselves in a good book surrounded by soft blue pillows resembling calming waters. No matter where students choose to read, they will find an abundance of books. The reading room has an extensive collection of over 1,000 books meticulously curated by the school's principal, reading interventionist and reading room book committee members.

Mary Anne Benton, a retired educator and Midland community member, led the charge for this reading room. Mary Anne worked diligently to secure the funding for the CSF's 250th reading room and hand-picked Henderson Elementary to be the recipient of the reading room. Her enthusiasm for the project brought individuals and organizations together to secure the resources needed to create this work of art. This room was made possible by the Ken W. Davis Foundation, the Henderson Elementary PTA and caring community members. The Henderson Elementary reading room is sure to inspire Midland's young scholars. They are learning the importance of reading and like the movie protagonist so elegantly articulated, "We can go anywhere, do anything" inside the pages of a book.

The CSF is honored to welcome Henderson Elementary into our Ben Carson Reading Room family. What started as one reading room in 2000 in Aberdeen, Maryland has blossomed into a network of 250 reading rooms serving students across the counrty. Social & Emotional Well-Being

The Covid-19 pandemic has meant a few years of crisis and uncertainty with students experiencing high levels of stress, trauma and anxiety. Educators across the country have expressed concern about their students' social and emotional well-being. When asked in a survey, 64% of educators in schools with Ben Carson/Think Big Reading Rooms articulated that they are highly concerned about their students' social and emotional well-being. The survey also revealed that 60% of administrators and teachers felt that Ben Carson/Think Big Reading Rooms provided emotional support during the pandemic. Scholar Spotlight: Grady Smith & Hayden Slade - Games to Give



Grady Smith, a 7-time Carson Scholar, and 6-time Carson Scholar Hayden Slade truly represent what it means to be compassionate leaders in the community.

In November of 2018, the dynamic duo from Ellwood City, PA began giving out board games to deployed U.S. soldiers, cancer patients and underprivileged children and adults. Hayden and Grady both love playing games in their free time, and they wanted to share that joy with those in need.

The boys had the idea for starting the organization after attending a Carson Scholar awards banquet. They shared, "We were inspired by Dr. Carson years ago when he challenged us to "THINK BIG!"

The organization has been thriving ever since, and Games to Give was recently approved as a 501(c)(3) by the IRS. This status allows the organization to apply for grant money and qualify for other fundraising programs. Games to Give raises money to buy and donate games through several organizations, including The Yellow Ribbon Girls, Club Hope and The Prevention Network. The organization also donate games to individual children and to several local toy drives.

In addition, the boys collect used games, rehabilitate them (making sure they are clean, complete and have instructions) and donate them to social service organizations. Before 2020, the boys had given away 286 new and used board games. To date, Games to Give has given away 1,581 board games, including 729 in 2021 — what an accomplishment!

The CSF couldn't be prouder of these extraordinary scholars and their commitment to serving others. Our scholarships are given to students who excel academically and possess humanitarian qualities. Hayden and Grady are reminders of why the community service aspect of our program is so important.

These scholars are changing the world, one game at a time!
